

## Week # 10 - Casual Observations

### Monday - Mar. 7<sup>th</sup> Ex. 39:1-40:38 (a summary)

- Priestly Attire - 39:1-31
- God's instructions finished - 39:32-43
- Who or what was Moses blessing? 39:43
- 39:30 Is 'HOLY TO JEHOVAH' written on your forehead?
- Many attempts have been made to find symbolic meaning in the priestly attire, what is yours?
- 40:3-15 The order of assembly has importance
- 40:16-17 One year from leaving Egypt the Tabernacle is finished and assembled.
- 40:17-33 The Tabernacle and all its articles are assembled according to design.
- 40:34-38 God takes up residence. His 'Kabod' (Glory) filled the tent (tabernacle)
- 40:30-32 "Washed", same word as John 13:3-16 oh 13:10 Jesus saith to him, He that is bathed needeth not save to wash his feet, but is clean every whit: and ye are clean, but not all. ASV

### Tuesday - Mar. 8<sup>th</sup> Lev. 1:1-4:35

- Moses' tent outside the camp was "the tent of meeting" and now "The Tent of Meeting" is the Tabernacle. Ex. 33:7-11; Lev. 1:1
- Burnt Offering 1:2-17 of the herd (3), the flock (10) or birds (14)
- Grain offering 2:1-16

- Grain always with salt 2:13 (salt of the covenant of thy God)
- 2:11-12 No leaven (yeast) or honey is to be offered except as offering (oblation) of first fruits
- 2:11-16 Some distinctions between types of grain offerings.
- Peace offerings 3:1-17
- 3:17 "It shall be a perpetual statute throughout your generations in all your dwellings, that ye shall eat neither fat nor blood."
- Sin offering 4:1-35
- 4:2-12 If a priest sins unintentionally bringing guilt upon the people (3)
- 4:13-21 If the people sin unintentionally
- 4:22-26 If leaders of the people sin unintentionally
- 4:27-35 If a common person sins unintentionally
- Common traits of sin offering - lay hands on head, blood sprinkled 7 times, blood touched to horns of incense altar, everything burned up, not eaten

### Wednesday - Mar. 9<sup>th</sup> Lev. 5:1-7:38

- Various types or distinctions of sacrifices: 7:37-38 Burnt, Grain, Sin, Guilt, Ordination and Fellowship
- 5:1-13 Various types of sin or trespass for Sin offering. Confession important. When offering two doves, one is a sin offering the other a burnt offering.
- 5:14-19 Guilt offering includes making financial restitutions

- 6:1-7 Intentional sin requires sacrifice and restitution plus 1/5<sup>th</sup> value
- 6:8-30 Regulations for Priests and Offerings
- The fire must not go out - 6:9,12
- 6:14-18 concerning the meal-offering and who shall eat what is left of the Lord's
- 6:20-23 What the priest offers for himself is holy and not to be eaten of his own portion
- 6:24-30 The priest that executes the offering eats from that one. His share or due
- 7:1-10 Regulations for the Trespass-Offering The hide belongs to the offering priest
- 7:11-15 Peace offering - can be eaten by the person rendering it but not after 2<sup>nd</sup> day
- 7:16-17 a vow or freewill offering also only eaten for 2 days
- 7:18 Eating the sacrifice on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day is an abomination, they incur guilt and nullify the sacrifices effect or purpose.
- 7:22-27 Two big no-no's Don't eat the fat or blood
- 7:28-38 What portions are the priests who do the work, a for ever clause

#### **Thursday - Mar. 10<sup>th</sup> Lev. 8:1-10:20**

- 8:1-36 The anointing, consecrating, ordination of Aaron and his sons - The ordered process
- 8:24 anointing with blood - right ear, thumb and big toe, 8:30 sprinkled the blood + oil on
- 8:33-35 Ordination process takes 7 days

- 9:1-7 Aaron and sons make atonement for themselves and the people (sin and burnt offering)
- 9:21 Wave offering?
- 9:22-24 Conclusion of offerings, (sin, burnt and peace offerings) Aaron blesses people, Moses and Aaron enter Tent and bless the people the God.
- 9:24 Fire from God/Jehovah consume the offering - people saw and shouted and fell on their faces.
- 10:1-20 The death of two of Aaron's sons, a study in itself. Offered unauthorized fir

#### **Friday - Mar. 11<sup>th</sup> Lev. 11:1-13:46**

- 11:1-8 Clean and unclean animals
- 11:9-12 Clean and unclean creatures of the water
- 11:13-19 Clean and unclean of the birds
- 11:20-23 Clean and unclean insects
- 11:24-29 Unclean swarming things
- 11:30-43 Dead things defile and make unclean
- 11:44-47 God's logic for these rules - He is Holy, so should His people be Holy
- 12:1-8 Laws/regulations of motherhood - males 7 days + 33 days = 40; females 14 days + 66 days = 80 (I am confident God knows something we do not)
- 13:1-59 Laws of leprosy and or various skin infections
- 13:4,5,11, 21, 26,31,33,45, Examples of quarantine and (45) wearing a mask and crying unclean
- God knows things about disease that humanity didn't - He said He would not visit the diseases of Egypt upon them -here is a method to not do it.
