Monday - Mar. 14th - Lev. 13:47-15:33

- 14:1-32 The laws of Leprosy (Skin disorders?)
- 14:4-7 Birds, cedar wood, scarlet and hyssop. Cleansing Chemistry 101 ish.
- 14:8-9 Twice shaved, all hair
- 14:14-18 or 25-29 An Anointing similar to the Priest's.
- 14:33-57 When God puts Laws of cleansing to teach them.
- 15:1-33 Laws of various oozes, flows, drips, runs and such that defile and make unclean.
- Terms for washing, rinsing, bathing and sprinkling

Tuesday - Mar. 15th - Lev. 16:1-18:30

- Continued from Chapt. 15 on things drip, ooze or flow or run.
- 15:31 Are these laws more about during the wanderings than after in the promised land?
- 16:1-34 How the Day of Atonement shall be done?
- 16:4 So, cleanliness allows you to get next to God-liness?
- 16:29-34 7th month 10th day every year for the sins of Priests and people of Israel
- 16:32 The one who is allowed to make atonement.

- 17:1-9 Only slaughter animals through the priests at the Tabernacle - no sacrifice to the demon/goat/vain god
- 17:10-16 Reasons for not eating blood, it is the blood that makes atonement - because it is a life. (see Heb.9:22 - no shed blood, no forgiveness)
- 17:15-16 washing hands and bathing important
- 18:3-5, 24-30 A dot connector - why the people of the nations were being cast out - 18:6-23
- 18:24-25 The real reason countries and peoples and lands become defiled and corrupted and contaminated - wickedness (see Lev.20:22-27)
- 18:6-18, 21, 22, 23 what or who to not have sex with, ever!
- 18:27 That which God has declared an abomination is still an abomination to Him.
- 18:30 "So keep my charge never to practice any of these abominable customs that were practiced before you, and never to make yourselves unclean by them: I am the LORD your God."

Wednesday - Mar. 16th - Lev. 19:1-21:24

- 19:1-8 A Holy God has expectations - His people should also be as He is - Holy
- 19:9-18 Some good "thou shall nots"
- 19:19-37 Some more "do's" and "don'ts" Why? - God's Logic! - Lev.19:37 "And you shall observe all

my statutes and all my rules, and do them: I am the LORD."

- 19:26, 31, 20:6, 27 Witchcraft and sorcery a BIG NO
- 20:1-5 No child sacrifices, no allowing others to.
- 20:6-7 God's opinion matters, don't do these things. Except verse 7 do do that!
- 20:10-21 Sexual wrongs - death or expulsion
- 20:22-27 Keep God's statutes and rules because we are His people and He is our Holy God. (Take to heart verse 23)
- 21:1-24 Rules governing being a priest. (you are 1)
- 21:4-8 "They shall be holy to their God and not profane the name of their God.

Thursday - Mar. 17th - Lev. 22:1-23:44

- 22:1-16 What Priests are not to do if unclean
- 22:7-33 Some rules for what makes a sacrifice acceptable for sacrificing.
- 22:29-33 (31)"So you shall keep.....I am the Lord"
- 23:1-44 The Feasts of the Lord
 1. 23:3 The Sabbath
 2. 23:4-8 The Passover
 3. 23:9-14 The Feast of Firstfruits
 4. 23:15-22 The Feast of Weeks
 5. 23:23-25 The Feast of Trumpets
 6. 23:26-32 The Day of Atonement
 7. 23:33-44 The Feast of Booths

- 23:2 "a Holy Convocation"? A Holy Assembly or A Holy Gathering

- 24:1-4 The Lamps before the Lord
- 24:5-9 The (*Show or Presence*) Bread (around a gallon of flour each)
- 24:10-16 Punishment for Blasphemy
- 24:17-23 Eye for eye, wound for wound
- 25:1-7 The Sabbath Year
- 25:8-22 The Year of Jubilee (50th Verse 10)
- 25:23-34 The redemption of property
- 25:35-46 Kindness for poor brothers
- 25:47-55 Redeeming a poor man
- 25:23,55 Who really owns whom?
