Eliphaz's 3rd reply to Job - 22:1-30

- Some bold statements about God 22:1-4)
- Some harsh accusations against Job 22:5-11
- Possible illusion to the pre-flood peoples 22:15-18
- An entreat to Job to submit and humble himself to God and God's presumed response if he would. 22:21-30

Job's 3rd reply to Eliphaz - 23:1-24:25

- Job's strong desire to plead his own case before God himself 23:1-7
- The elusiveness of God 23:8-10
- Job holds to his own course as from God himself 23:11-12
- Job renders a long list of the wicked's behavior 24:1-25

Bildad's 3rd reply to Job - 25:1-6

- God is exalted above all else who can search out His glories? 25:1-6

Job's 3rd reply - 26:1-31-40

(3 sections - 27:1-23; 28:1-28; 29:1-31:34)

- Sarcasm from Job - 26:1-4
- Job's list of God's doings 26:7-14
- A saying "As God Lives" 27:2
- Question 28:12 answered 28:28 Take this to heart
- Interesting translation for 29:18 the Phoenix rather than sand (only in a Heb. Trans)
- Oh that all married men would make this covenant and that married woman would do likewise for their side 31:1
- Two true and reasonable conclusions 31:15, 23 We should remember who made us and who holds our life.

Elihu speaks - 32:1-37:24

(Final Dialogues - Truths told)

- Elihu has a more detailed pedigree 32:2,6
- Where true understanding comes from 32:8-9
- Phrase - "tip of my tongue" 33:2
- A glimpse of what God does behind the scenes 33:14-30
- Some truths - God is not wicked, He does keep man alive by His own breath 34:10-15
- God is impartial 34:17-19
- When it is time, it is time 34:19-30 for nation or man
- One of Elihu's addresses of Job's words - what or who does our life, for good or bad, have an effect? 35:2-16
- "God my maker" 36:3
- 36:15 deep is this thought
- Some purposes of rain and snow 37:5-13
- One reason people fear God, He doesn't pervert justice 37:23-24
