

Week # 28 Casual Observations

7-11-2022 1Chr.25:1-31; 1Chr.6:31-53; 1Chr.26:1-32

Question: How was it determined who would be in charge of what gate? Who was given what gate?

Answer: 1 Chr.26:13-19

- 1Chr.25:1-31 the divisions of the musicians and singers - 24 courses/groups with 12 in a course
- 1Chr.6:31-53 a review of the descendants from Aaron who performed their duties before the Tabernacle
- 1Chr.26:1-19 The divisions of the gate keepers and their assigned gates (5 total gates)
- 1Chr.26:20-32 The assignments for treasurers and other official duties

7-12-2022 1Chr.27:1-29:22; 1Kg 1:1-27 **Question:**

Where did the plans for building the temple come from? **Answer:** 1 Chr.28:11-19 (19) God

- 1Chr.27:1-15 The military divisions and their months of order - 24,000 per month
- 1Chr.27:16-34 Leaders appointed over areas from livestock and fruit bearing trees and vines to workers in the fields etc.
- 1Chr.28:1-8 David charges all Israel concerning Solomon as King
- 1Chr.28:9-21 David charges Solomon with the duties of his kingship to God and Kingdom and Temple.

- 1Chr.29:1-9 David tells Solomon what things he has prepared and laid up for the Temple build
- 1Chr.29:10-21 David prays for Solomon and the temple and the people
- 1Chr.29:22 The 2nd anointing of Solomon as king and Zadok as priest (also anointed Zadok if law was to be followed - Ex.29:7; Num.35:25)
- 1Kg.1:1-4 David in his old age given a bed warmer
- 1Kg.1:5-10 Adonijah sets himself up as king instead of Solomon
- 1Kg.1:11-27 Nathan the prophet and Bathsheba come before David to inform him of the threat to Solomon's ascension to the throne

7-13-2022 1Kg.1:28-40; Ps.25; 1Kg.1:41-2:9; 2Sam.23:1-7; 1Kg.2:10-11; 1Chr.29:26-30; 1Kg.2:12; 1Chr.29:23-25 **Question:** Where was the horn of sacred oil for anointing kept? **Answer:** 1Kg.1:39

- 1Kg.1:28-40 Solomon anointed King at Gihon - a spring or pool on the west side of Jerusalem - very public place
- 1Kg.1:39 the anointing
- 1Kg.1:40 earth split? From the rejoicing?
- Ps.25 An honest plea for mercy and forgiveness and for being taught God's right ways.
- 1Kg.1:41-50 Adonijah is told the great noise is the rejoicing for Solomon being anointed King
- 1Kg.1:51-53 King Solomon spares Adonijah's life

- 1Kg.2:1-9 David gives Solomon some final instructions including what to do about several individuals who had wronged David
- 2Sam.23:1-7 David's last words - a prophetic oracle
- 1Kg.2:10-12; 1Chr.29:26-30 The death of King David (the chronicles of David's reign written where? What are these works?)
- 1Chr.29:23-25 Solomon takes David's place on his throne.

7-14-2022 1Kg.2:13-3:15; 2Chr.1:1-13; 1Kg.3:16-28;

Ps.72 **Question:** What prophecy was fulfilled by Solomon after he became king? **Answer:** 1Kg.2:26-7; 1Sam.2:30-36 (Abiathar was the last of Eli's line by Ithamar fulfilling prophecy)

- 1Kg.2:13-21 Adonijah makes request to Solomon through Bathsheba for Abashag
- 1Kg.2:22-35 Solomon executes judgment against Adonijah, Joab and the priest Abiathar
- 1Kg.2:36-46 Solomon also issues a verdict against Shimei for his hand against king David
- 1Kg.3:1-15 and 2Chr.2:7-13 Solomon is visited by God in a dream while at Gibeon and Solomon asked Him for wisdom and so God gives him much
- 2Chr.2:1-6 Solomon worships God where the tabernacle and the great bronze altar are - Gibeon

- 1Kg.3:16-28 Solomon demonstrates his wisdom by offering to cut a child in two

- Ps.72 The last prayer/blessing of David for Solomon,

7-15-2022 Ps.50; SoS.1:1-4:16 **Question:** What should not be aroused until it so desires? **Answer:**

- Ps.50 A psalm by Asaph - some great words concerning God. God speaks concerning His tolerance of the wicked.
- Ps.50:10-15 God owns ever thing, all creatures on earth.
- Ps.50:16-20 (16) it is not a good thing for the wicked to recite God's word, it defiles it.
- Ps.50:23 be like these words speak of a person, be that person.
- SoS.1:1-4:16 I don't want to talk about it
