7-18-2022 SoS.5:1-8:14; Ps.45; 1Kg.5:1-12; 2Chr.2:1; 2Chr.2:3-16 **Question:** What is the reason Solomon gives for why the Temple he is going to build will be great? **Answer:** 2Chr.2:5

- SoS 5:1-8:14 How shall we discuss such material? I am not sure how to evaluate it.
- Ps.45 A tribute to God - Your Throne is forever
- 1Kg.5:1-12 Example of good diplomacy and good relation between fathers and father's sons.
- 2 Chr.2:1 Solomon's proposes/plans for building
- 2Chr.2:3-16 Solomon's words to King Hiram, David's friend, asking for skilled craftsmen and materials

7-19-2022 1Kg.5:13-18; 2Chr.2:2; 2Chr.2:17-18; 1Kg.9:15-16; 1Kg.9:20-23; 2Chr.8:7-10; 1Kg.6:1-38; 2Chr.3:1-17; Ps.127; 1Kg.7:1-12 **Question:** Solomon had two of these built, one on the north and one on the south side, what are they and what did he name them? **Answer:** 2Chr.3:17

- 1Kg.5:13-18 and 2Chr.2:2; 17-18 The arraignments for construction labor
- 1Kg.9:15-16 A gift to Solomon - dowry of his Egyptian wife
- 1Kg.9:20-23 and 2Chr.8:7-10 The inhabitants, non Israelites put into forced labor
- 1Kg.6:1 A time stamp - 480 years after Israel came out of Egypt

- 1Kg.6:2-38 and 2Chr.3:3-17 A description of the building of the temple (compare readings)
- 2Chr.3:1-2 Time stamp and location of Temple build
- Ps.127 Unless the Lord builds the house
- 1Kg.7:1-12 Solomon also build his house or palace with court for judging

7-20-2022 1Kg.7:13-51; 2Chr.4:1-5:1; 1Kg.8:1-21; 2Chr.5:2-14 **Question:** So just where does Solomon say the Lord said He would dwell? Did He? **Answer:** 1Kg.8:12 (see also 2Chr.6:1)

- 1Kg.7:13-51 and 2Chr.4:1-5:1 Some details of the various parts of the Temple (compare details)
 - 1Kg.7:3-4 The head craftsman, Hiram was half Israelite
 - 1Kg.8:1-21 and 2Chr.5:2-14 The bringing of the Ark into the Temple, God is worshiped, God responds
- 7-21-2022** 2Chr.6:1-11; 1Kg.8:22-61; 2Chr.6:12-7:3 **Question:** Solomon demonstrated how to pray, not only in words but also in what posture is good to pray from or in? **Answer:** 2Chr.6:12-13

- 2Chr.6:1-11 Solomon addresses the people - reviews what God had promised and what was accomplished.
- 1Kg.8:22-53 and 2Chr.6:12-42 David's prayer of dedication for the Temple
- 1Kg.8:54-61 Solomon's blessing over the people
- 2Chr.7:1-3 God shows up powerfully

2Chr.9:21 **Question:** What was King Solomon's reason
for not letting his wife, the daughter of Pharaoh, live
in the palace of David's? **Answer:** 2Chr.8:11

- 1Kg.8:62-66/1Chr.7:4-10 The dedication of the Temple and it's court
- Ps.132 A promise made and fulfilled - The Lord has chosen Zion
- 1Kg.9:1-9/2Chr.7:11-22 The Lord appears to Solomon, gives confirmation and warning
- 1Kg.9:10-14/2Chr.8:1-3 Solomon builds up other places after the Temple and Palace - King Hiram not pleased with gifted cities
- 1Kg.9:24/2Chr.8:11 Pharaoh's daughter's house - away from Jerusalem and the Ark of God
- 1Kg.9:25 Solomon's regular practice of Worship/sacrifice
- 1Kg.9:17-19/2Chr.8:4-6 The building up of the store houses and fortified cities
- 1Kg.9:26-28/2Chr.8:17-18 Solomon gets gold by way of the sea, a venture with King Hiram
- 1Kg.10:22/2Chr.9:21 Ships every 3 years - a precious cargo
