**8-15-2022** Ecc.11:1-12:14; Ps.73; Ps.88; 1Kg.11:41-43; 2Chr.9:29-31; 1Kg.14:21; 2Chr.12:13-14 **Question:** Explain Ecc.12:1-8 **Answer:**

- Ecc.11:1-8 Live beyond just yourself, invest in it
- Ecc.11:9-12:8 The life cycle, young to old - an accounting for it
- Ecc.12:9-14 The end of the matter - fear God
- Ps.73 The ways of the wicked seem good until you experience God in His Holiness - You are my all
- Ps.88 A deep, repeated cry for help and deliverance
- 1Kg.11:41-43/2Chr.9:29-31 Solomon dies, 40 year reign, his son Rehoboam succeeds him
- 1Kg.14:21/2Chr.12:13-14 Rehoboam establishes himself in Jerusalem, city chosen by the Lord but

**8-16-2022** 1Kg.12:1-19; 2Chr.10:1-19; 1Kg.12:20-24; 2Chr.11:1-4; 1Kg.12:25-31; 2Chr.11:13-17; 1Kg.12:32-13:34 **Question:** Who became the priests for Israel under Jeroboam's Reign? **Answer:** 1Kg.12:31; 2Chr.13:33-34

- 1Kg.12:1-19/2Chr.10:1-19 Rehoboam accepts wrong council, cost him 10 tribes to Jeroboam - prophecy coming into reality
- 1Kg.12:20-24/2Chr.11:1-4 Jeroboam called and made king over all Israel except Judah. God intervenes through Shemaiah to prevent war

- 1Kg.12:25-31/2Chr.11:13-17 Jeroboam enacts a plan to keep Israel from going to worship in Jerusalem - introduces false gods/idols
- 1Kg.12:32-13:34 Jeroboam institutes a festival to compete with the one in Jerusalem - it brings God's wrath and prophecy of doom
- 1Kg.13:1-3 a prophecy for a future Josiah of the house of David

**8-17-2022** 1Kg.14:1-18; 2Chr.11:5-12; 2Chr.11:18-23; 1Kg.14:22-28; 2Chr.12:1-12; Ps.89 **Question:** What happened in the 5th year of King Rehoboam's reign as King? **Answer:** 1Kg.14:25-26 and 2Chr.12:1-4, 9-

- 1Kg.14:1-18 Jeroboam finds out about his fate and his children's too - the prophet Ahijah speaks a future prophecy (14:7-11) also (12-18)
- 2Chr.11:5-12 Rehoboam strengthens his territory
- 2Chr.11:18-23 Rehoboam marries and has children, Abijah by Maachah daughter of Absolom appointed as future successor
- 1Kg.14:22-28 Rehoboam leads Judah in evil and looses the temple treasures to Egypt because of it
- 2Chr.12:1-12 Description of the lose to Egypt and why - also God's limits on judgment - learn a difference between whom you serve
- Ps.89 Exalted praise to God's steadfast love, but

What 3 things was Israel without for a long time?

**Answer:** 2Chr.15:3-7 (1-7)

- 1Kg.14:29-31/2Chr.12:15-16 The records of "?" several different records kept - Rehoboam's death
- 1Kg.15:1-8/2Chr.13:1 A brief explanation of the passing of the kingship from Jeroboam to his son Abijah and his brief reign and his son Asa taking over
- 2Chr.13:2-20 A short war/battle between Abijah and Jeroboam - Abijah's speech
- 2Chr.13:21-14:1 Abijah and his family - wives and concubines and sons and daughters (how so many in 3 years?)
- 1Kg.15:9-11 Asa's reign (20th year of Jeroboam)
- 2Chr.14:1b-7 Asa - he did what was right
- 1Kg.14:19-20 Jeroboam's end after 22 years, Nadab is next over Israel
- 1Kg.15:25-31 Nadab's short reign, murdered by Baasha according to prophecy - his whole family killed.
- 2Chr.14:8-15:7 Asa started out well, reigned 41 years - called on the Lord - 15:1-7 God speaks by Azariah
- 1Kg.15:12-15 Asa expels evil - the male shrine prostitutes too
- 2Chr.15:8-19 Asa leads Judah and others back to worship the Lord

Jehoshaphat begin to do in his 3rd year of reign?

**Answer:** 2Chr.17:7-9

- 1Kg.15:33-34 Baasha in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of Asa's reign became king and reigned 24 years
- 1Kg.15:16/15:32 War between Asa and Baasha
- 1Kg.15:17-22 Asa fails to seek the Lord against Baasha, seeks help from Ben-Hadad king of Damascus
- 2Chr.16:1-10 Expanded story of 1Kg.15:17-22
- 1Kg.16:1-33 Doom prophesied against Baasha and his son Elah by Jehu followed by Zimri's very short reign.
- 1Kg.16:23-28 Omri gains the throne briefly
- 1Kg.16:29-33 Ahab, Omri's son reigns
- 1Kg.15:23-24/2Chr.16:11-14 Asa and his end - diseased feet and failure to seek the Lord
- 2Chr.20:31-34/17:1-2 Jehoshaphat reigns after Asa, he walked in the ways of Asa and David
- 2Chr.17:3-18:1 Jehoshaphat did some great and good things especially in educating his people about God (7-9)
- 2Chr.16:34 Prophecy fulfilled about Jericho
