10-17-2022 Jer.2:1-4:32 **Question:** The Lord said His people have committed two sins, explain what they are? **Answer:** Jer.2:13

- Jer.2:5 does what or who is worshiped have an effect upon the worshiper?
- Jer.2:9 Does sin effect future generations?
- Jer.3:1-3 What defiles a land and its people?
- Jer.3:6-10 What lesson can be learned from these verses?
- Jer.3:11-20 Can you see something of God's Mercy in these passages?
- Jer.3:21-4:2 God's desire: be honest and repent.
- Jer.4:3-32 Judgment and disaster comes from the north

10-18-2022 Jer.5:1-6:30; Jer.13:1-27 **Question:** Judah and Jacob were told that their wickedness and sins had kept what away from them and deprived them of what? **Answer:** Jer.5:24-25

- Jer.5:1-9 God looks for reasons to not punish.
- Jer.5:10-31 God asks tough questions, tough.
- Jer.5:24-25 What benefit is there in fearing God? There is benefit!
- Jer.6:1-30 Destruction comes, who will head the warning - remember the old paths
- Jer.6:27 I have been one too - my secret name

- Jer.13:1-14 God gives a strange assignment
- Jer.13:20-25 if this...then that...

10-19-2022 Jer.16:1-17:27; 2Kg.22:3-20; 2Chr.34:8-33 **Question:** What did King Josiah do with the book of the Law? **Answer:** 2Chr.34:29-32

- Jer.16:1-15 Some don'ts bring questions but who can bear the answer except a future hope attached
- Jer.17:5-18 Some great words: 7-8; 9-10; 14
- Jer.17:19-27 God really wants the Sabbath honored back then, what about now?
- 2Kg.22:3-7 and 2Chr.34:8-13 There are times when repair is necessary and yields more than expected.
- 2Kg.22:8-20 and 2Chr.34:14-33 What can we learn about God and man's relationship in this passage? Is humble response to God good?

10-20-2022 Nah.1:1-3:19; 2Kg.23:1-28; 2Chr.35:1-19 **Question:** What all did King Josiah desecrate when he started cleaning house around Jerusalem (the temple)? **Answer:** 2Kg.23:8,10,13,16

- Nah.1:3,7,15 In the midst of judgment against Nineveh praise for God.
- Nah.3:1-4 Nineveh's sins include witchcraft and sorcery and harlotry - oh how much like USA.
- 2Kg.23:1-3 King Josiah reestablishes covenant with God and so do the people. (interesting that

the book of the Law of Moses was lost for so long)

- 2Kg.23:4-25 King Josiah and Judah's leaders and priests and Levites clean up Israel and Judah and Jerusalem.
- 2Kg.23:15-18 A prophet's bones and prophecy fulfilled but from where? (even spoke his name)
- 2Kg.23:24-25 High praise for King Josiah
- 2Kg.23:26-28 Too little too late
- 2Chr.35:1-19 Josiah has the Passover celebrated for Judah and Israel like no king since the days of Samuel

10-21-2022 Ps.81; Jer.47:1-48:47; 2Kg.23:29-30;

2Chr.35:20-36:1 **Question:** So what was the final fate of King Josiah and at whose hands? (was there a warning from God?) **Answer:** 2Kg.23:29-30 and 2Chr.35:20-25

- Ps.81 a Psalm of celebration to God - blow the shophar
- Jer.47:1-8 Doom and destruction to the Philistines.
- Jer.48:1-47 Doom and destructions to Moab.
- 2Kg.23:29-30 and 2Chr.35:20-36 King Josiah's fate, he should have enquired of God. Object lesson, maybe, what would it be?
- 2Chr.35:25 Jeremiah composed laments (dirges) for King Josiah, wonder were they are now?
