10-24-2022 Jer.22:1-17; 2Kg.23:31-37; 2Chr.36:2-5; Hab.1:1-3:19 **Question:** Habakkuk contains a conversation between two, who are they and what is their conversation? **Answer:** Habakkuk - Hab.1:1-4; 1:12-2:1; God - 1:5-11; 2:2-20

- Jer.22:1-5 Still good to do these things and be that kind of person.
- Jer.22:13-17 Some insight on how to be a king (You are one, right? Rev.1:5-6 5:10 KJV)
- 2Kg.23:31-37 and 2Chr.36:2-5 a changing of kings and names
- Hab.2:6-20 Woe, woe, woe, woe and woe
- Hab.3:2 Can you say Amen to this?

- Jer.8:21 Humanities conduct has effect upon God
- Jer.3:7-9 In our day it is called being politically correct
- Jer.9:12-15 What person is wise enough?
- Jer.9:23-24 How well do you really know God?

- Jer.10:6-7 Still true, there is no one like You O Lord, no one.
- Jer.10:10-16 Idols of any kind are still stupid and so are those who worship them but God is Almighty, the Creator and His wrath is real too.

- Jer.7:20-8:3 God gave the Israelite nation more law that just how to do sacrifices but those laws they would not obey. What does God want?
- Jer.11:1-17 Simple words of the Covenant, "Obey Me."
- Jer.11:14 like 7:16 and we will see it again - "don't pray for this people..... I will not listen!"
- Jer.15:10-21 Jeremiah pleads his own defense, he is being troubled but God protects the faithful.
- Jer.22:18-23 Harsh word against King Jehoiakim
- Jer.35:1-19 A family who knew how to obey

- 2Chr.36:6-7 and Dan.1:1-2 Jehoiakim's fate.
- Jer.36:1-32 A great view into Jeremiah's life as a prophet and how he and God's word was received.
- Jer.25:1-7 a time stamp - 23 years for Jeremiah.
- Jer.25:11-12 The time stamp for exile in Babylon
- Jer.25:15-17 Can you explain the cup of wine?
- Jer.45:1-5 Is there a lesson we can learn here?

10-28-2022 Jer.46:1-28; Dan.1:3-21; 2Kg.24:7;
Dan.2:1-49 **Question:** Who is Belteshazzar?
Hananiah? Mishael? Azariah? **Answer:** Dan.1:6-7

- Jer.46:1-28 A message of woe for Egypt but a future hope too.
- Dan.1:3-21 The petition for food - vegetables and water - God blesses.
- Dan.2:1-49 The first dream and God's giving Daniel insight above all the reat.
- Dan.2:20-23 Great prayer to God from Daniel.
- Dan.2:44 A view of the distant kingdom, the church. Yes or no?

Twice Jesus said: "I desire mercy, and not sacrifice." Mat.9:13 and Mat.12:7 (quoted from Hos.6:6, Mic.6:6-8 and Isa.1:11-17) This weeks readings share a similar understanding, can you find them? Is this still the heart of our Lord and God, Jesus?
