1Jn.1:5-7

1Jn.1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.

Moses stood in the cleft of a rock as God shielded him with His hand as He walked past so that His Glory would not destroy him. The radiance from God's shielded passing left Moses' face glowing for days. (Ex.33:18-23; 34:5-8; 29-35) And Israel was covenanted to walk in the Light of God.

Then came Jesus, God's light toned down into human flesh, so that man might survive the encounter. Jesus knew His own past Glory. He knew His future glory and He understood His current diminished Glory. (Jn.17:5,22,24) And we have been invited into His Present Glory. (Rm.5:2; 8:21)

Paul insists that we thru Jesus Christ gain more than Moses gained. (2Cor.3:7-11,18) How can this be? When does this happen? I desire to behold this Jesus whom the Holy Word of God declares is "the radiance of the Glory of God and the exact representation of His being..." (Heb.1:3)

John challenges the children of God to walk in God Light. When you became one of His children thru your rebirthing He placed within your mortal flesh His eternal Spirit. You have been changed. Your mortality has been modified, changed into immortality. (1Cor.15:53; Eph.4:20-24; Rm.8:9)

You who are redeemed have received from the very Hand of God; life. Jesus has said:

- Jn.3:36 Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.
- Jn.5:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.
- Jn.6:47 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has eternal life.
- Jn.17:3 And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.

John insisted that He wrote the Gospel content that he did so that we might have eternal life thru your believing that Jesus is the Christ. (Jn.20:31) Paul concludes thru what Jesus revealed to him that we have who are redeemed have received a new life. (Rm.6:4) Therefore be reason of these truths; come out of the shadows and walk in the Light as children of light. (1Jn.1:5-7; Eph.5:8; 1Thes.5:5)
